HealthWest Community Health Center (Dental) 208- 232-3368- A dental facility that provides preventive and restorative care for children and adults. This community center does process private dental insurance, Medicaid, and offers a sliding fee scale for dental services. Hours: Mon thru Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturdays by appointment only.

Idaho Smiles Program (Medicaid) Statewide 1-800-233-6262 MCNA Participant Representatives may be called M-F 6am-6pm MST at 1-855-233-6262 MCNA administers the dental benefits for participants of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare Medicaid Basic and Pregnant Women Plans. The participant receives an Idaho Smiles card with a customer service number for a list of participating dentists. (A provider directory is available at the web address). Idaho State University Dental Hygiene Clinic (in Pocatello) 208-282-3282 A teaching facility of Idaho State University Department of Dental Hygiene offers exams, cleaning, x-rays and dental referrals at reduced fees for adults and children completed by ISU Dental Hygiene students (checked by ISU instructors). Payment required at time of service – the clinic will submit private insurance claims and Medicaid.

Idaho State University Department of Dental Sciences 208-282-3289 The Idaho Advanced Education in General Dentistry Residency operates from two clinical training sites, one in Pocatello and one in Meridian. The residency offers State of the art facility, 5 operatories and one surgical suite, and provides preventive and restorative care. Patients pay according to a sliding fee scale based on household income and family size.

To be seen at the Pocatello Free Clinic, you cannot have **any** form of dental insurance. call number above to be added to their wait list. Services provided by volunteer dental hygienist: full mouth digital s-rays, prophylaxis cleaning, periodontal scaling and root planning, periodontal maintenance procedures, full mouth debridement, oral hygiene education. volunteer dentist Provides: treatment planning, digital x-rays, exams, composite fillings, zirconia crowns, Denture consultations, full upper and lower dentures, upper and lower partials, in-office soft relines for dentures, extractions, and surgical extractions.
